²⁴ But Jesus on His part did not entrust himself to them, because He knew all people ²⁵ and needed no one to bear witness about man for He himself knew what was in man.

POINT #1 Nicodemus Comes at Night.

John 3:1-2

"Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews. 2 This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with him."

POINT #2 Nicodemus doesn't understand the Invitation from Jesus.

John 3:3-4

Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

⁴ Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?"

POINT #3 Jesus is the means for a New Birth.

John 6:63-65 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life. 64 But there are some of you who do not believe." (For Jesus knew from the beginning who those were who did not believe, and who it was who would betray Him.) 65 And He said, "This is why I told you that no one can come to Me unless it is granted him by the Father."
